The COVID-19 pandemic has influenced the business and education worlds (6) many ways. From school age to work retirement age, almost everyone has been affected. Let us look at the world of business.  Undoubtedly the largest impact has been the switch to having employees working remotely at least some weekdays. For businesses, long accustomed to (1) all their employees in one location, with direct supervision by managers, this has been a major challenge.  (2) remote working requires, of course, a stable broadband internet connection and all of the necessary computer equipment in the remote location. Any technical failure or a break in the connection can have major problems for workers logging into their company databases or holding meetings on platforms such as Zoom. Remote connections also present challenges to security measures.  The upside for most employees is the reduction in stress that results (3) long commutes on crowded trains, especially with the potential spread of the virus in crowds. Workers can sleep a bit longer, take a little more time getting ready to start work, dress casually, and avoid irritating coworkers in the elevators at the office.
Perhaps the most positive advantage is not having their work interrupted by constant phone calls during the lay.
The downside is being stuck at home all day. If they have children who are also at home all day, then they have to deal with their own work and their children's demands. And (4) their previous complaints about the office," they miss the <u>camaraderie</u> of friends at work and going out to lunch together.
Even when restrictions are eventually lifted and in-office work becomes more common, there is another ssue to consider: how (6) days a week should people go to the office? Already there is speculation that employees will want at least one day a week away from the office. The leading candidate according to informal surveys is Wednesday. On the other hand, working at home is just too lonely for the majority, so employees probably will want to come to their offices at least once in a while, for the camaraderie. While it is hard to predict exactly how things in the workplace will change, it is safe to say that there will not be a full return to the previous "normal."
